Color


Artists organize the colors of the rainbow in a color wheel. The color wheel helps them see how colors mix together.



RED, YELLOW and BLUE are the 3 primary colors.

2 primary colors mixed together make a secondary color. The secondary colors are PURPLE, ORANGE and GREEN.






The color wheel can be cut into cool colors (GREEN, PURPLE and BLUE) and warm colors

(YELLOW, ORANGE and RED).

Complementary Colors


Complementary colors are best friends!
They make each other brighter!




They are on opposite sides of the color wheel. They create a **high contrast**, like black and white.




Colors that are neighbors on the color wheel create a **low contrast**.






Color in the pictures in complementary colors.


Red and Green!



Blue and Orange!




Purple and Yellow!




Cool and Warm Colors

Cool Colors




Warm Colors
